ENEL GENERACIÓN COSTANERA INCREASED INVESTMENTS BY 172% IN 9M 2018

Nicola Melchiotti, Enel's country manager in Argentina, said: "We are implementing a significant investment plan to further increase the efficiency and reliability of this valuable asset. Looking ahead, we will continue to work relentlessly to further boost Costanera's service quality, benefitting the country's power generation system and security of electricity supplies."

Buenos Aires, October 29th, 2018 – The Board of Directors of Enel Generación Costanera S.A. ("Costanera") approved the company's financial results for the first nine months of 2018.

- Revenues increased in 9M 2018 compared with 9M 2017 mainly due to the exchange rate effect, as
 the company's results are registered in US dollars, in line with Resolution SEE No. 19/2017, effective
 since February 2017.
- **EBITDA** also increased in line with revenues, partially offset by higher salaries following review of wages in the electricity sector and higher maintenance costs
- EBIT grew in line with previous indicators, more than offsetting the 8% rise in depreciation due to the increase in the company's asset base.
- Net income also increased, more than offsetting higher net financial charges registered in 9M 2018, due to the impact of the Argentine peso's depreciation against the US dollar on US dollar-denominated debt and the increase of the interest rate by Argentina's Central Bank.
- Net debt increased slightly as a result of the impact of the Argentine peso's depreciation against the US dollar on US dollar-denominated debt.



Capex increased by 357 million ARS, mainly following maintenance work on both of the plant's CCGT units. Investments addressed maintenance of generation units, aimed at optimising plant availability and reliability.

MAIN OPERATIONAL INDICATORS

• Costanera's energy output was 5,226 GWh in 9M 2018, a 18% decrease vis-à-vis the 6,338 GWh generated in the same period of 2017, due to lower demand from the system and lower plant availability during maintenance works.
